2024-25 Policy and Guidelines

September 1st - May 31st

_____ **Tuition** with Mohr Music School is a monthly flat rate based on the school year September 1st - May 31st. Tuition is billed and withdrawn automatically on the 1st of each month.

There will be 32 weeks of instruction and you will be billed for 30 weeks. This allows for 2 flex weeks if your family will be absent, has a scheduling conflict or needs to cancel due to illness. Otherwise you will receive two free lessons. The rate is divided by 10 months into monthly payments from September to May. June, July and August will be optional instruction months with weekly payment options based on your and your teacher's availability.

Please keep in mind that regardless of if there are 2 lessons in a month or 5 the charge will stay the same as the price has been calculated based on the average amount of lessons per month in a year.

Tuition fees include your lessons, all recital fees, supplemental materials, lesson books (on an as needed basis determined by your instructor), printing costs of sheet music and travel fees.

_____ **Weeks of No Instruction:**

* Thanksgiving Week: Nov. 25th - 29th, 2024

* Christmas Break: December 9th, 2024 - January 10th, 2025

* Spring Break: April 14th - 18th, 2025

_____ **Tuition Pricing** is as follows:

- 30 Minute Lessons = \$125/month
- 45 Minute Lessons = \$180/month
- 1 Hour Lessons = \$245/month (Siblings back to back ok)

_____ **Cancellations/makeups:**

- Your time slot is reserved specifically for you.
- If you need to cancel any lessons beyond the provided 2 flex lessons included in your tuition, I will try my best to schedule a makeup if there is an opening in my schedule the same week. Please try to give me 24 hour notice, of course with unexpected events such as illness a shorter warning is acceptable. Virtual lessons are an option for makeups when there are no openings for in person available. There are no credits and if we are unable to make it up, the lesson will be forfeited.
- Lessons canceled by me will always be subject to a makeup lesson.
- I will be available for lessons for all holidays with the exception of the weeks of no instruction listed above.
- Tuition is non-refundable. 30 days notice is required to terminate lessons.

_____ **Payment** will be set up for automatic deduction through your student portal on the first of the month for the current month. Payment is due on the 1st of the month. If there is an issue with payment deduction, a late fee of \$15 will apply after the 5th of the month. After the 15th of the month, the account will be suspended until the account balance is current. Cash at the first lesson of the month will also be accepted.

_____ **Sick policy:** If you or your student are running a fever, vomiting, have a contagious condition such as Covid, chicken pox, the flu, pink eye, or other contagious illness please cancel your lesson.

_____ **Travel:** Please allow about 5 min for me to arrive early or late as traffic can be unpredictable at times. I always try my best to arrive on time. If I will arrive more than 5 min late, I will contact you. Please rest assured that your student will always receive his/her full lesson time regardless of my arrival time.

_____ **Summer:** If you plan to take lessons during the summer, the weekly rate will be \$35 per 30 min lesson paid weekly through the student portal, Venmo, Cash or Check.

_____ **Recitals** will be offered one to two times a year based on interest in participation. Although participation is highly encouraged, it is not required. Your tuition covers all recital fees whether you choose to participate or not. There will not be an extra charge to take part in these performance opportunities. If you choose to not participate, your flat rate tuition will not change.
